Answers

$$\begin{array}{ll} \text{a)} \quad \frac{1}{3} \times \frac{1}{4} = \frac{1}{12} & \text{e)} \quad \frac{6}{7} \times \frac{4}{5} = \frac{24}{35} \\ \\ \text{b)} \quad \frac{3}{5} \times \frac{1}{5} = \frac{3}{25} & \text{f)} \quad \frac{1}{6} \times \frac{7}{9} = \frac{7}{54} \\ \\ \text{c)} \quad \frac{5}{6} \times \frac{1}{2} = \frac{5}{12} & \text{g)} \quad \frac{9}{11} \times \frac{3}{4} = \frac{27}{44} \\ \\ \text{d)} \quad \frac{2}{3} \times \frac{2}{5} = \frac{4}{15} & \text{h)} \quad \frac{7}{12} \times \frac{7}{12} = \frac{49}{144} \end{array}$$
