

Simple Multiplication Word Problems

Answers

- a) There are 5 carrots in a bag. I have 3 bags of carrots. How many carrots do I have in total?
 $5 \times 3 = 15$
 I have 15 carrots in total.
- b) A bicycle has 2 wheels. There are 9 bicycles. How many wheels are there in total?
 $2 \times 9 = 18$
 There are 18 wheels in total.
- c) There are 10 students in each class. There are 6 classes. How many students are there in total?
 $10 \times 6 = 60$
 There are 60 students in total.
- d) A steak costs \$11. I buy 5 steaks. How much money have I spent?
 $11 \times 5 = 55$
 I have spent \$55.
- e) There are 3 dogs. How many legs are there in total?
 Each dog has 4 legs.
 $4 \times 3 = 12$
 There are 12 legs in total.
- f) I draw 8 triangles. How many sides have I drawn altogether?
 Each triangle has 3 sides.
 $3 \times 8 = 24$
 I have drawn 24 sides altogether.
